2. Purpose of Agreement

4. Non-Circumvention Clause

The parties hereby agree not to directly or indirectly circumvent or attempt to circumvent each other or the intermediary with respect to any current or future transactions.

This clause applies to all contacts introduced by the intermediary.

5. Duration

This agreement shall remain valid and enforceable for a period of 30 months from the date of execution.

6. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of Taiwan.
